#### A Critical Juncture for Mountain Community Resources

This year's Mountain Affair comes at a crucial time for Mountain Community Resources. Limited funds are straining our ability to meet our community's mounting needs. Your participation is more important than ever to ensure we can continue to provide the following essential services:

- **Community Advocacy:** Bi-lingual, bi-cultural support for housing, employment, education, childcare, and more
- **Counseling:** Free counseling services through pre-licensed clinical counselors for youth, families, and individuals
- **East West Natural Health Clinic:** Community-based natural health clinics, offering health screenings, natural medicines, and acupuncture (by appointment)
- **Emergency Preparedness:** Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) trainings twice a year, with free classes and materials
- **Food Distribution**: In partnership with Second Harvest Food Bank, we provide free groceries and nutritional guidance every Thursday
- **Parent Education:** Classes and one-on-one sessions on a variety of parenting topics, available in Spanish and English, funded by First 5 Santa Cruz County
- **Public Benefits Enrollment Assistance:** Help with enrollment and reporting for government benefits and services like Cal-Fresh, unemployment, MediCal, and CoveredCA
- **Showers, Laundry & Hygiene Services:** Complimentary access to showers, laundry facilities, and hygiene services, available Monday through Thursday by appointment

Every dollar raised goes directly toward providing these essential services to more than 1,000 valley residents, helping them meet basic needs, prepare for emergencies, recover from disasters, and build a brighter future.


